From the Manchester area: Take historic route 7A south, approximately 15 miles. Look for our road sign in Shaftsbury. Just after the Hillbrook Motel, take a sharp right onto Myers road. The farm is 3.5 miles on the right side. You will pass three other farms and a large hill before you reach our farm.

From the South:

From the Bennington area: Take historic route 7A north. Look for Wm. Daily Concrete on the right. Take a sharp left onto Myers road, which is the next road. The farm is 3.5 miles on the right side. You will pass three other farms and a large hill before you reach our farm.
